

JNZ POINTS RANKING LIST

A Points Ranking List (PRL) has been introduced for all age groups from December 2009. Points can be gained by achieving results at approved events. Results from annual events can only feature once on the list, and other events (such as PacRims – held every two years), will only feature if it is within the last 12 months of the date of the ranking list.

The PRLs will be available on the JNZ website in the “Results” section, and will be updated regularly.

The points system will NOT :

- differentiate between larger and smaller categories
- take into account if players had come up against one another on the day of the event
- award points to players who failed to win any matches - except uncontested gold medals

The points system WILL :

- give points to individuals only in the categories they participate in
- be the basis for team selections
- be used for seeding of players at local events
- reflect the points gained over a 12 month rolling period for Cadets, Juniors and Seniors, and a calendar year for under 13’s and -10’s.
